

Useful German Phrases

For your reference, here are some common German greetings (Grüße) and pleasantries translated to English:

- → Hallo Hello! universal greeting
- → Guten Morgen Good morning
- Guten Tag Greeting used throughout the day, more formal than "hallo"
- Guten Abend Good evening
- Gute Nacht Good night! only used when taking leave of somebody, assuming that somebody will go to bed now
- → Auf Wiedersehen Good bye formal
- Tschüss Bye less formal than "auf Wiedersehen"
- Danke thanks
- Bitte please; You're welcome. used on a variety of occasions: when asking somebody to do something, when giving him something and as reply to "Danke".
- → Wie geht's? How are you?
- → Gut good, well
- Sprechen Sie englisch? Do you speak English?
- Deutsch German
- → Ja yes
- → Nein no
- Prost Cheers!
- Entschuldigung Excuse me; I'm sorry
 Said both when trying to get somebody's attention and when you have made a mistake.
